

GENERAL TRACK DAY **GUIDFLINES** 2021

INFORMATION FOR MOTORCYCLES FOR SHARFD TRACK DAY WITH KARTERS

GENERAL TRACK RULES:

- NO RIDING MOTORCYCLES IN OPEN DIRT PARKING AREA.
- All riding must be done on track with approved safety gear.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited during all events.
- No persons (except track officials) are allowed on the track.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times.
- Spilling or dumping oil, fuel, or any other substance is strictly PROHIBITED.
- Riders are responsible for all persons in their pit.
- Overnight camping is not allowed.
- Speeding in the pits (all vehicles) is strictly PROHIBITED.

MOTORCYCLE GUIDELINES:

The following guidelines are enforced for motorcycles and attendees of Santa Maria Karting Association (SMKA). All Guidelines will be followed or will result in any attendee being removed from the event. Adherence to these guidelines is strictly enforced for the safety of riders and spectators, as well as any other attendees of the events.

Acceptable Motorcycle Sizes:

50cc to 549cc 4-Stroke Supermoto / 50cc to 390cc Sportbike / 50cc to 250cc 2-Stroke

All motorcycles will be tech inspected by an appointed SMKA Track Day official. The official will assess the readiness of the motorcycle for use and an inspection label will be adhered. The following MUST be completed to pass tech inspection BEFORE being allowed on track:

- All drain and fill bolts to be wire tied or have a dab of RTV silicone to prevent loosening.
- All axle nuts are wire tied or have a dab of RTV silicone. Lock nuts are

also acceptable but you may be asked to dab them with silicone as a precaution.

- Over flow tanks for carburetor and crank case are highly recommended but are not mandatory.
- All controls must be in full working order: Brakes, Clutch, Throttle, Kill-Switch, Shift Levers, etc.
- No dirt or dual-sport tires allowed.

SAFETY GEAR:

All riders must wear full safety equipment when on track at all times. Safety gear will be tech inspected by appointed official. The following are required on all safety equipment:

- All safety gear in good condition with no major damage, wear, or tears.
- Single piece suits should be made of leather or other highly durable material. Textile race suits will not be allowed unless they are made of Kevlar and have CE approved armor.
- 2-piece suits are allowed but must have at least a ¾ zip upper and lower connection.
- Full face helmets with DOT rating or better only. Dirt bike helmets are allowed but must be full face. Eye protection (goggles) will be required if using full face dirtbike style helmets. No bicycle or mountain bike helmets will be permitted.
